UWWC will also begin Summer Lead & Learn, a new program that is a summer volunteer- and project- based opportunity for youth, 12-15 years old. SLL will provide a limited number of youth the opportunity to learn more about societal issues and their social responsibilities, thus becoming leaders for a better community for all. The program is set to launch in June and will include three two-week sessions. Individuals can attend one week, two weeks, or all if they choose. SLL is a fee-based program. More details will be made available at the end of this month.
